Q: What major event occurred in Oakland changing the face of medicine in Pittsburgh on Jan. 19, 1911?

A: On Jan. 19, 1911, The Elizabeth Steel Magee Hospital opened in on the Christopher L. Magee homestead known as The Maples.

Q: What is the significance of the date October 15, 1915 in Magee's history?

A: The date the permanent Magee Hospital, which could accommodate 140 adults and 85 infants, was ready to receive patients.

Q: Why is March 8, 1901 such an important date in Magee's history?

A: It is the date that Christopher Lyman Magee died. His estate became the first site of Magee-Womens hospital and his will funded the hospital's creation.
