

UPMC Oakland Campus Master Plan

The UPMC Oakland campus, comprised of UPMC Presbyterian and UPMC Montefiore and many outpatient and office buildings, is committed to providing high-quality, comprehensive healthcare to the residents of our community. We are building on that commitment by proposing a number of expansions and projects that will allow for a higher level of patient care and convenience. Our Master Plan, which is required by the City of Pittsburgh, incorporates many projects, including:

- Removal of the old Children’s Hospital building.
- New inpatient tower constructed on the site where the old Children’s Hospital currently is and part of what is now green space near Fifth Avenue.
- Construction of building above the current Montefiore parking garage.
- The creation of an urban loop:
 - Proposing to make Meyran Avenue one-way from Forbes Avenue, Lothrop Street one way from Fifth Avenue to Terrace Street; and Darragh Street one-way from Terrace to Fifth. Terrace would remain a two-way street.
- Addition of a bus terminal in front of the new inpatient building.
- Relocation of clinical pathology labs currently in the old Children’s Hospital building to a renovated Rangos Research Center on the corner of Fifth Avenue and McKee Place.

Additional details will be announced at a later date. Although these projects are proposed, no plans have been finalized.
