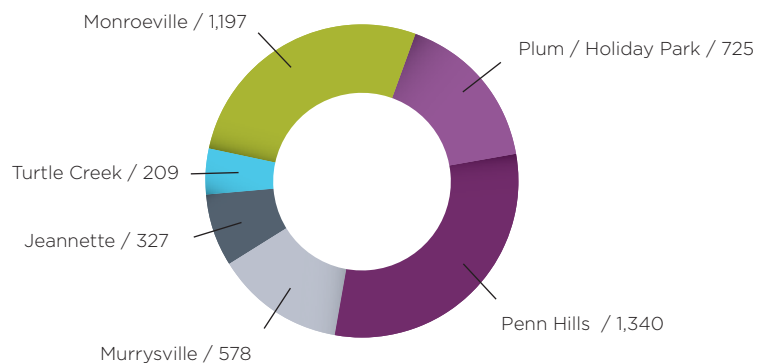
- UPMC East's \$250 million facility consists of all private patient rooms and patient-centered amenities to promote a pleasant stay for all patients.
