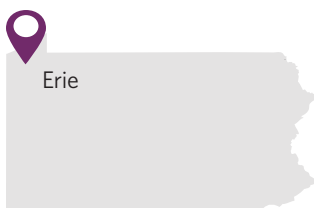
- UPMC is a \$12.8 billion integrated global health enterprise, whose strength allows it to continue to contribute to the region's health care needs.
