





What is Community HealthChoices?

<u>Community HealthChoices (CHC)</u>: Pennsylvania Department of Human Services program that contracts with managed care organizations to coordinate care for all adults who are dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid services. This includes coordinating physical health care and Long-Term Services and Supports (LTSS) for people who are nursing home *eligible but living in the community* or *residing in nursing home facilities*.

<u>Program Goals</u>: Assisting people to live or work in the setting of their choice including their home, residential setting or nursing facility: Focuses on restoring participants functional independence – not just treating their medical needs. Embodies whole-person care and support with broadened access beyond clinical care to housing, employment, and socialization services.


