The State Board of Medicine accepts the passing grade on the certifying examination of the ACNM (American College of Nurse Midwives) as determined by the ACNM.
OTHER	The nurse midwife is authorized to perform certain medical services as defined in a signed written agreement (collaborative agreement) between the midwife and the collaborating/supervising physician. The collaborating/supervising physician is an Allopathic or Osteopathic physician who has UPMC Horizon privileges in obstetrics and/or gynecology, and who has entered into a collaborative agreement with a nurse midwife. A CNM shall practice within the limits established by the Collaborative Agreement and clinical privileges specifically requested and granted to the CNM by the Hospital even if the scope of practice/privileges of a CNM is broader under the State law and regulations. Applicant must be able to document current clinical competence in nurse midwifery within the past 24 months. ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS 1. Current demonstrated competence and an adequate level of current experience, documenting the ability to provide services at an acceptable level of quality and efficiency. 2. Current certification in neonatal resuscitation by the American Heart Association and the American Academy of Pediatrics.
