Pathologist Assistant	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Graduate of an approved Pathologist Assistant program, or 2. Graduate of an approved academic Histology, Cytology, or M.T. Curriculum with ASCP certification or obtain ASCP certification within one year of hire. Must have a minimum of one (1) year experience in a hospital laboratory functioning equivalent to a Pathologist Assistant, or on-the-job training under the direction of a Pathologist for one (1) year, or 3. For Histotechnologists and cytotechnologists it will suffice to be ASCP certified with a minimum of one (1) year experience doing Pathology gross dictation, or 4. Pathology Medicine Residents who have completed a minimum of six (6) months of anatomic residency training doing pathology gross dictation. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Written approval granted by employing physician, i.e. signature on application & Delineation of Clinical Functions. 2. Three (3) references providing evidence of acceptable clinical experience. 3. Completion of Clinical Interview with Administrative Director/Lab 4. Provisional period of one (1) year is required. Written evaluation must be completed at the end of the provisional period by the Medical Director of Pathology Department indicating that the Pathologist Assistant has demonstrated appropriate skills to carry out the clinical functions as stated. The provisional period may be extended for an additional six (6) months as deemed necessary by the appropriate Medical Staff department. 5. Periodic Review will be done every two (2) years. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Evidence of liability insurance. 2. Agree to abide by appropriate written Bylaws. 3.
