ACLS Completed *; ATLS Completed *; PALS Completed *</p> <p><i>*Physicians who are board certified/board eligible and residency trained in Emergency Medicine are not required to obtain these certifications</i></p> <p>2. Electrical Cardiac Pacing Transvenous – Submit logs for past 2 years; otherwise, requires proctoring of first case.</p> <p>3. Ultrasound Privileges – Evidence of training and experience must be submitted and will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.</p>
