An applicant certified in Orthopaedic Surgery who has not completed the required one (1) year clinical fellowship described above but who has had a minimum of two (2) years experience in the two (2) years preceding appointment in a setting whereby a minimum of 25% of their surgical cases consisted of pediatric age patients. Applicants applying under the two (2) year experience clause must demonstrate by surgical logs the minimal 25% pediatric ratio or
 - An applicant possessing a specific area of expertise not provided by pediatric fellowship trained orthopaedic surgeons.

Pediatric Orthopaedic Satellite:

- Initially board certified in Orthopaedic Surgery
- Ongoing board certification in Orthopaedic Surgery
- One (1) year clinical fellowship in Pediatric Orthopaedic Surgery. An exception to the fellowship requirement may be made following approval of the Division Chief, Surgeon-in-Chief, Credentials and Medical Executive Committees for:
 - c. An applicant certified in Orthopaedic Surgery who has not completed the required one (1) year clinical fellowship described above but who has had a minimum of two (2) years experience in the two (2) years preceding

<u>Reappointment/Pediatric:</u> 50 Pediatric Orthopaedic surgical cases in the past 24 months.
