| <b>CERTIFICATION</b> | Board Eligibility/Board Certification in Family Practice or Pediatrics   |
| <b>OTHER</b>         | <p>For Care of such newborn less than 2,200 grams, less than 35 weeks gestational age, or with significant illness requiring close observation or adjunctive therapy: Physicians are required to become certified in AHA/AAP Neonatal Resuscitation and to maintain current certification at all times.</p> <p>For Neonatal Care Privileges in Newborn Surgery the following requirements must be met:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Physicians with training sufficient for Board Eligibility/Board Certification in Family Practice or Pediatrics who meet the following criteria:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>– N.R.P. Certification</li><li>– Minimum of one month rotation in neonatal critical care nursery during residency</li><li>– Minimum one month formal training in critical care following residency</li><li>– Current certification in AHA/AAP Neonatal Resuscitation</li></ul></li></ul> |
