Completion of at least 3 years in a U.S. or Canadian accredited residency training program in general/child psychiatry. Appointment to the St. Margaret Medical Staff. Familiarity with mental health law, including procedures for involuntary commitment and treatment. Satisfactory evidence of professional liability coverage, data bank information disclosure and Act 33 clearance where appropriate. Physicians are expected to seek consultation and supervision from a more experienced colleague when treating patients with uncommon disorders, general medical complications and/or who fail to respond to treatment as expected.
