Physician Coach Approach Training

Physician Thrive, in partnership with <u>Rex Gatto, Ph.D.</u>, is excited to offer a Physician Coach Approach Training (PCAT).

This coaching curriculum is designed specifically for physicians to learn the peer coaching: philosophy, background, tools, fieldwork practice, and skills to be effective. After four (4) half-day sessions, with associated field work and assessments, each participant will be a **UPMC Designated Peer Coach**.

The Peer Coach is an important role in supporting and helping a peer physician gain a wider or better perspective on his/her situation.

There is no one size fits all in coaching but the following are statements of reflections to consider if you will be an effective peer coach.

- Listen without judging (be able to keep an open mind without judging the coachees).
- Help to problem solve. Develop alternatives for difficult working situations. Help the peer physician recognize alternative ways to develop, enhance or correct actions.
- Advise but do not dictate the action the peer physician should take.
- Encourage. Draw out. Focus on successes, help to build self-esteem of the coachee.
- Guide but don't direct. Help develop coachee's skills and abilities.
- Create and be a safe haven to discuss professional and personal issues without judging.
- Ask questions to identify peer physician's values and attitude.
- Remember coaching is a pulling out process not a pushing in process. Focus on application (doing).
- Take notes during your meetings as a referral and a way to see progress and development.
- Being able to use your wisdom with care and compassion.
- Remember your job is helping to build the coachee's professional future
- Be a role model.
