UPMC Med**Link** is a software application that offers participating practices that have an existing EHR (Electronic Health Record) system an electronic link to information about their patients' tests, admissions, and other information from UPMC hospitals and practices at which they have received health care services.




MedLink PDF integration integrates with your printer or file share on office computer.


