

UPMC MedLink is a software application that offers participating practices that have an existing HER (Electronic Health Record) system an electronic link to information about their patients' tests, admissions, and other information from UPMC hospitals and practices at which they have received health care services.

What are the types of UPMC clinical data that can capture and send to you:

- ❖ Laboratory General lab and microbiology
- ❖ Clinical Pathology
- ❖ Radiology (i.e. x-rays, CT scans)
- ❖ Cardiology (i.e. EKGs)
- ❖ Gastroenterology exams (i.e. colonoscopies)
- ❖ Ultrasounds
- ❖ Documentation (i.e. Discharge summaries, Operative reports)

There are three ways a practice can integrate:

If you have an electronic health record (EHR)....

MedLink EHR integration integrates directly into your current workflow and you never have the need to leave your EHR.

You don't have an EHR.

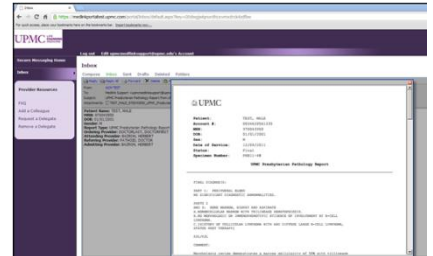
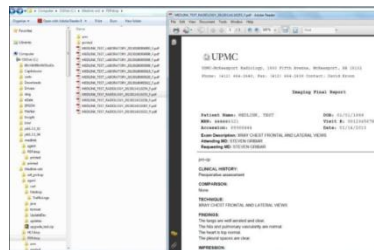
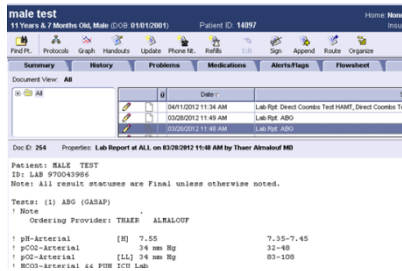
Do you manage your patient population and clinical care on the computer?
