The Erie Psychological Consortium emphasizes an experiential model of training across a number of clinical settings. The Northshore rotation exposes Interns to neuropsychological assessment on an inpatient rehabilitation unit and outpatient setting with close collaboration with our practicing psychologists. The UPMC Safe Harbor rotation focus consists of outpatient treatment utilizing individual and group treatment and clinical psychological and neuropsychological assessment. This broad-brush approach prepares interns for a variety of post-doctoral settings. Close attention to detail, sound time management skills and punctuality are emphasized.
