

The hospital's beginnings trace back to more than a century ago, when Greenville Hospital, later Greenville

Regional Hospital, was founded in 1906. The former Shenango Valley Osteopathic Hospital, later the Shenango Valley

Medical Center, opened in 1960. In 1992, the two hospitals merged to form Horizon Health System, which merged with UPMC in 1998.

UPMC Horizon's two hospital campuses, network of satellite locations, and affiliated doctors offices throughout Mercer, Lawrence, and Crawford counties in Pennsylvania and Trumbull and Ashtabula counties in Ohio offer seamless access to primary care and specialty services to its patients.

Bariatric Surgery


UPMC Horizon is accredited through the Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery Accreditation and Quality Improvement Program (MBSAQIP). This designation recognizes surgical programs with a demonstrated track record of favorable outcomes in bariatric surgery.

Breast Imaging

The Womancare Center of UPMC Horizon is accredited by the American College of Radiology (ACR) and designated as a Breast Imaging Center of Excellence. Breast imaging services include digital mammography, ultrasound, and stereotactic breast biopsy.

Electronic Health Records

UPMC Horizon's two hospital campuses and community doctors' practices are part of UPMC's network of electronic health records. The hospital is one of approximately 1,200 in the nation to achieve the Stage 6 designation of the HIMSS Analytics Electronic Medical Record (EMR) Adoption ModelSM, a distinction that honors efforts to implement technology to improve patient safety and quality care.



UPMC CancerCenter at UPMC Horizon

UPMC CancerCenter, partner with the University of Pittsburgh Cancer Institute, at UPMC Horizon provides high-quality cancer care to residents in Mercer County. Patients have access to cancer-fighting tools and techniques, including targeted radiation treatments, advanced anti-cancer drugs, and the latest cancer clinical trials. These services are complemented by a cancer care team that understands the importance of both comprehensive support and the dynamic communities served by UPMC Horizon.

Birth Place at UPMC Horizon

To accommodate the increasing number of babies born at UPMC Horizon every year, the hospital unveiled an expanded and renovated Birth Place at its Shenango Valley campus in spring 2015. The unit includes a labor and delivery area, a surgical suite for Caesarean sections, rooms dedicated to postpartum care and obstetrics and gynecology patients, and Level I and Level II nurseries. The Birth Place staff includes certified obstetrics nurses, breastfeeding counselors, and car seat technicians, as well as a neonatal nurse practitioner.

For high-risk obstetrics patients, telemedicine services provide a connection to maternal-fetal medicine experts at Magee-Womens Hospital of UPMC and neonatologists at Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh of UPMC.

Surgical Services at UPMC Horizon

With a wide range of available surgical specialties and significant investments in facilities and technology, UPMC Horizon is the destination for world-class surgical care in the Mercer County region. From general surgery to specialties including bariatric, breast, thoracic, orthopaedic, urologic, and vascular surgery, UPMC Horizon offers a quality, patient-centered experience from the preoperative testing phase to recovery. Our facilities include operating rooms specifically designed for minimally invasive surgery and ambulatory surgery suites featuring high-definition endoscopy equipment. Inpatient and outpatient surgical services, along with ambulatory services and endoscopy procedures, are available at both the Greenville and Shenango Valley campuses.

Hospitalist Service

UPMC Horizon offers one of the fastest-growing trends in health care: a hospitalist program. This beneficial program consists of a dedicated doctor or group of doctors — called hospitalists — who take care of patients admitted to UPMC Horizon. The doctors and advanced practice providers in UPMC Horizon's hospitalist program organize and keep on top of all aspects of patient care, including communication with primary care doctors, during patients' hospital stay and when they are ready to leave the hospital.

Satellite Locations


UPMC Horizon's satellite locations include several outpatient centers and doctors' practices, which provide access to primary and specialty doctors as well

Residency Programs

UPMC Horizon has offered postgraduate medical education programs since 1962. The hospital currently offers residency programs in family medicine and general surgery. Both programs are approved by the American Osteopathic Association.

A low resident-to-doctor ratio allows residents to establish close, personal relationships with their mentors. From the very beginning of their training, residents participate in hands-on patient treatment and assume responsibility for their patients' health and well-being. After graduating from the program, many of UPMC Horizon's residents go on to join practices in the hospital's service area.

Womancare Center

Located in Hermitage, the Womancare Center of UPMC Horizon combines several specialty doctors' practices — including advanced women's health and the Children's Hospital Specialty Care Center Hermitage — and diagnostic imaging and laboratory services under one roof. The center also hosts a variety of events, including support group meetings, community lectures, and health fairs.

Greenville Medical Center-UPMC

Greenville Medical Center-UPMC hosts both primary care and specialty doctors' practices, as well as x-ray and laboratory services.

New Wilmington and Mercer Locations

X-ray and laboratory services are available at UPMC Horizon's outpatient centers in New Wilmington and Mercer.

Community Practices

UPMC Horizon's community doctors' practices are located in Conneaut Lake, Greenville, Grove City, Hermitage, Linesville, Mercer, Sandy Lake, Sharpsville, and West Middlesex in Pennsylvania, and Andover and Kinsman in Ohio.
