Note

Routine testing is not necessary for low-risk procedures e.g., cataracts, colonoscopies, endoscopies, or cystoscopies unless deemed necessary by the anesthesiologist.

H&P: within 30 days/update within 24 hours of surgery.

Consent: Within 90 days of surgery.

Otherwise healthy patients do not require testing unless procedure requires T&S or T&C per *Maximum Surgical Blood Ordering Schedule (MSBOS) guidelines.

MSBOS: Recommendations for blood bank testing/products is available on OR schedule. T&S or T&C requires ABO Check Sample if no historic type is available in database.

These guidelines are for routine testing. Specialized testing should be ordered at the discretion of the physician and clinical indication should be written in the order. These guidelines do not apply to pediatric patients.
